

Notes for Contributors to the Journal

1. Manuscripts should be printed in **font 12 pts in double space on one side of good quality** white paper with margins of at least 3.5 centimetres and **should not exceed 5000 words/12 pages including original drawings, essential tables and cited references. It should be submitted in original along with a CD.** A copy of the paper may be retained by the author for ready reference. The papers will not be returned to the authors in case of rejection or delay in publication. The copyright will belong to The Geographical Society of India.
2. Manuscripts should contain (i) **a short title** and (ii) an **abstract** of the paper not exceeding 100 words.
3. **Relevant references should be given at the end of the paper arranged alphabetically by author**, followed by the year of publication within parentheses, name of the book/article, journal, name of the publisher, the place of publication and relevant pages in succession conforming to the standard followed in the Review. Only those references which are used in the text should be included.
4. **Footnotes should be avoided.**
5. **Maps and line drawings should be in deep black drawing ink suitable for reproduction on the page format (A4) of the Review and should be captioned. Colour drawings may be published, if the cost is borne by the authors in advance @ Rs. 1000/- each.** If the drawings are not satisfactory and redrawn ; such charges for drawing shall be levied upon the author. **Only the original drawings should be submitted.**
6. Units of measurement should be in the International (Metric) system only.
7. The Oxford English Dictionary should be followed for disputed spellings.
8. No abbreviation whatsoever, like ‘m’ for million or ‘t’ for tonnes, should be used .
9. While sending contributions to the Review, the **authors should certify that**
 - i) **the article has not been published and would not be submitted elsewhere for publication.**
 - ii) **that the drawing charges if any be paid by me/us @ Rs. 250/- each.**
10. All authors/co-authors should be members of The Geographical Society of India.
11. The Honorary Editor is endowed with full right to edit and adjust articles in order to conform to the Review’s format.
12. The Geographical Society of India or the Honorary Editor will not be held responsible for the views expressed by the author/s in the Review.

Articles not conforming to the above rules may not be considered for publication. Articles, notes, book reviews, etc. are accepted for publication with the approval of the Publication Committee of the Society.
